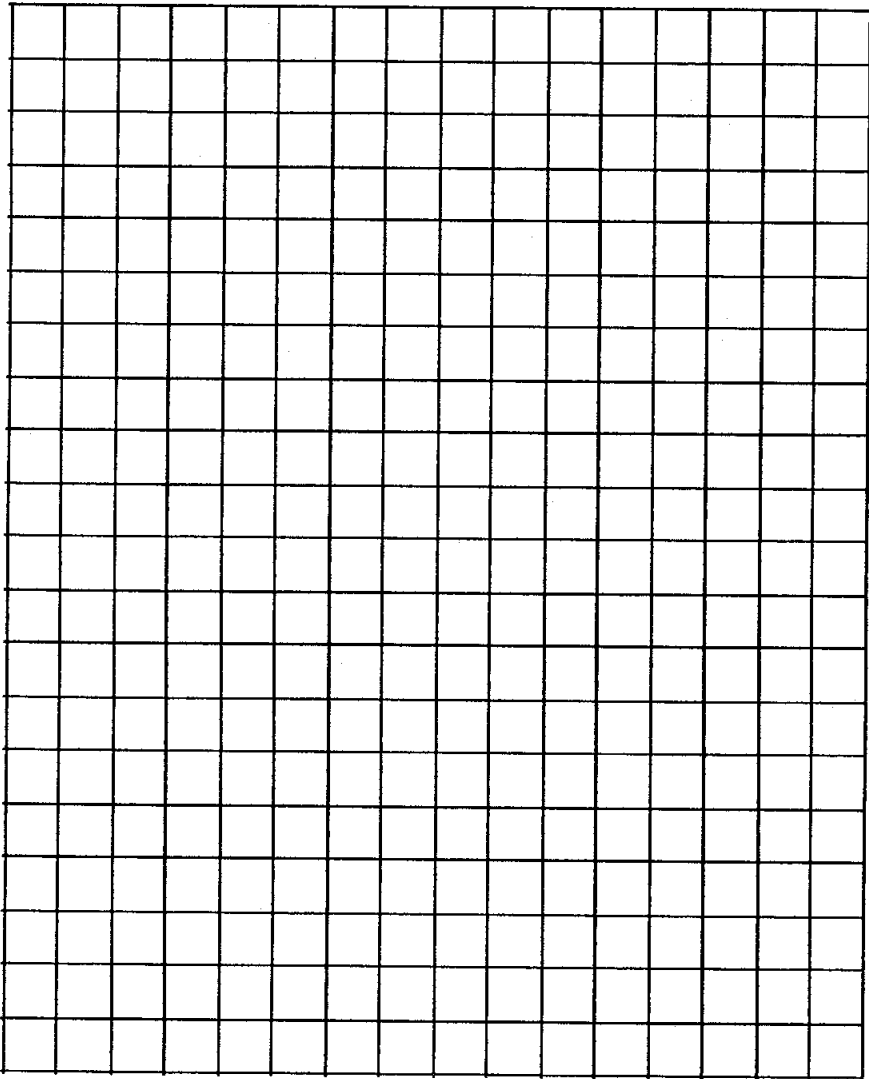

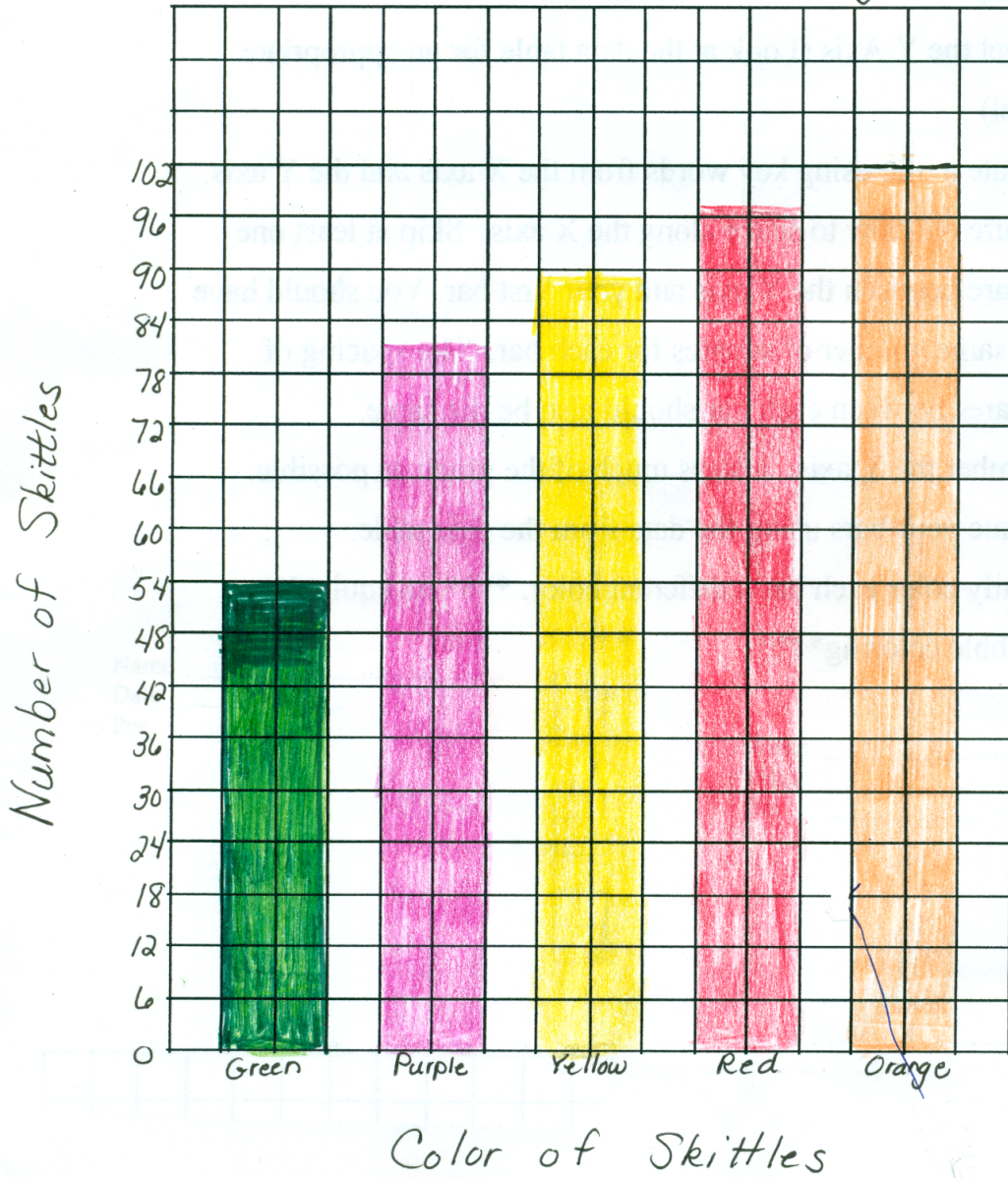


Sample Bar Graph

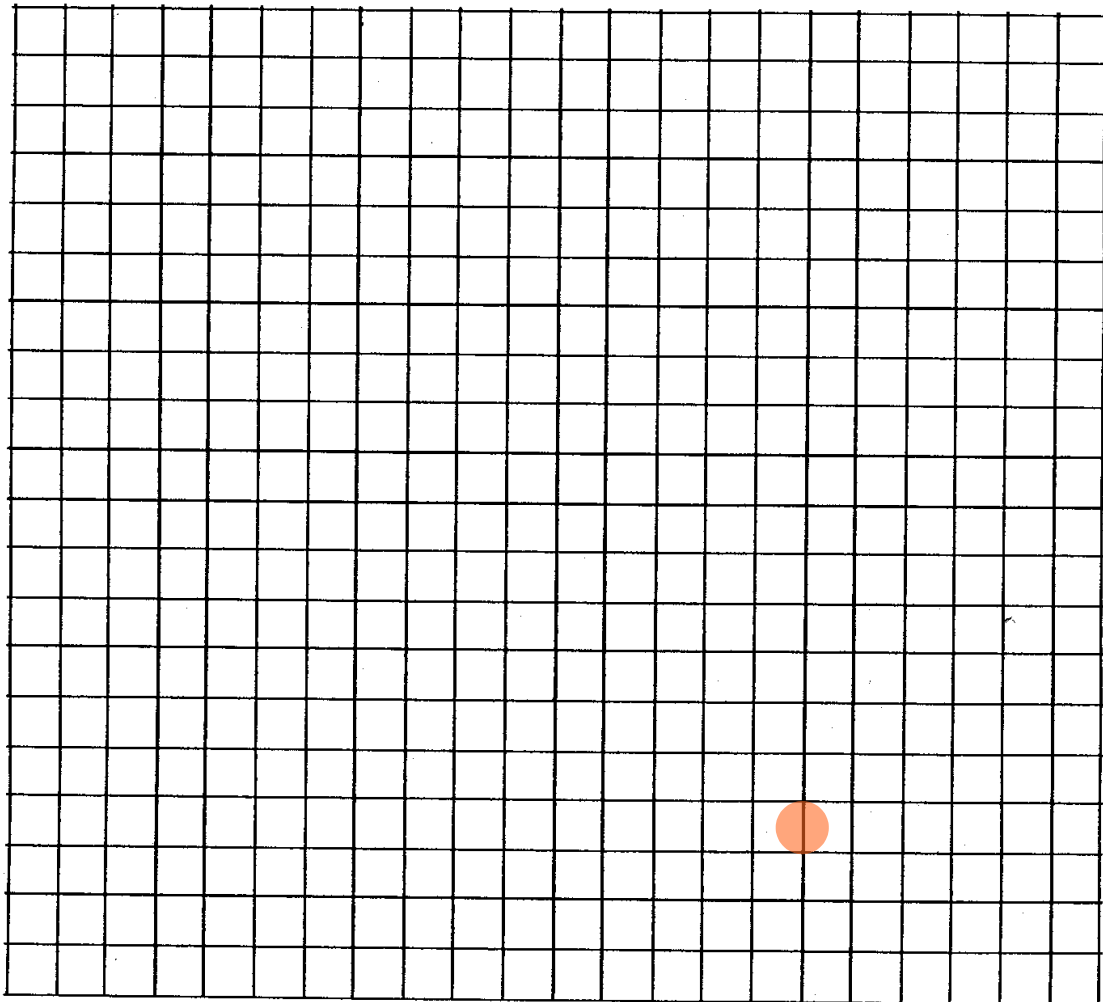
