Create a comic strip with a story where the main character changes between the three states of matter (solid, liquid, gas) at least once. Example: Mr. Icicle begins as a solid, melts into a liquid puddle, and evaporates into a gaseous cloud.

Include a title for your comic strip.

Your comic strip must have a minimum of four frames. Each frame must have a quality illustration, details, and be completely colored.

The story must make sense and there must be at least one word in each frame. The words of the story should indicate why the change of state is happening. For example, the main character might say, "I'm melting because it is so warm in here!"
